We are excited for the future with OIO increasing our focus on key industry, science and regional partnerships to better support community of startups and entrepreneurs.

UNDERSTANDING OUR IMPACT

Ocean Impact Organisation exists to positively impact ocean health - it's in our name. As we enter our fifth year, we reflect on the achievements and set our sights on the future impacts that we, and the startups we support, can create.

This snapshot illustrates OIO's impact data for 2023 in comparison to 2022. Data from OIO's programs in 2020 and 2021 is included in totals but not explicitly mentioned in tables.

As with previous snapshots, the impact data shared represents 'leading metrics,' that is, the impact that OIO as an organisation has as we pursue our mission: to support and accelerate ocean impact businesses. As our organisation grows and the portfolio of companies we support matures, we will "dive deeper" into the tangible impacts startups are having on ocean health, in line with the best-practice methodology developed by others in the ecosystem, including the 1000 Ocean Startups coalition.

In 2023, we edged closer to the number one objective we set ourselves in 2020: **Accelerate 100 startups and entrepreneurs.** With a total of 99 supported to date (58 startups; 41 entrepreneurs), we will far exceed this goal in 2024.

We made one minor enhancement to Impact Area 3 in 2023, whereby we are now presenting the # total number of attendees/participants at OIO events, due to OIO delivering increasing physical activities post-pandemic to bring our digital community into the real world.
